



The Bill Bernbach Diversity Scholarship Program

Bill Bernbach ignited advertising's *creative revolution* in the 1960's and redefined the industry by building a unique shop based on the power of creativity and humanity. Bill and his fellow revolutionaries, recognized that in order to succeed, a true creative environment made up of the most talented individuals from different backgrounds, cultures and ethnicities must exist.

In 1998, DDB Worldwide honored its founder and the company's values with the establishment of The Bill Bernbach Diversity Scholarship Program. To date, DDB has awarded 80 scholarships to multicultural students for creative excellence in the disciplines of art direction and copywriting.

This year, in our search for the next cohort of Bernbach Scholars we are extending the program for the first time to eligible senior high school students to apply prior to their enrollment in college.

Awards are as follows:

Senior High School Students:

Two \$2,500 scholarships and a summer 2020 internship with a DDB Worldwide agency in the U.S.

The Bill Bernbach Diversity Scholarship program is funded by DDB Worldwide Communications Group Inc, its employees, its holding company Omnicom, and outside donors. It is administered by the 4A's Foundation, Inc., a charitable institution founded and operated in collaboration with the American Association of Advertising Agencies.

Eligibility for Senior High School Students

To be eligible for The Bill Bernbach Diversity Scholarship Program, you must be:

1. African-American/Black, American Indian/Alaska Native*, Asian-American**, Native Hawaiian or other Pacific Islander***, or Hispanic
2. A senior in high school attending college in the fall of 2019
3. A citizen, national or legal permanent resident of the United States as of the date the application is submitted
4. A candidate with a demonstrated interest in advertising or a related field, who is able to provide a creative portfolio for review in art direction or copywriting

* American Indian/Alaska Natives will be asked to provide proof of tribal membership or a certificate of descent from a state or federally recognized tribe if selected as a scholarship candidate.

** Asian-Americans includes persons having origins in the Far East, Southeast Asia, or the Indian subcontinent.

*** Native Hawaiians or other Pacific Islanders includes persons having origins in Hawaii, Guam, Samoa, or other Pacific Islands. Citizens of the Republic of the Marshall Islands, Federated States of Micronesia, and the Republic of Palau are eligible.

4. Most Recent Transcript

Award recipients are required to submit the items below. Scholarships are contingent upon successful submission of these items.

1. A Letter of Recommendation (from a faculty member)
2. Reference from a Previous Employer (if applicable)
